WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Application for Westside Ringette Association Scholarship Award may be made by:

- Ringette players whom have for a minimum of one season registered with Westside Ringette Association, or
- Participated as a coach and/or mentor with Westside Ringette Association, or
- On-ice Ringette-certified official with Westside Ringette Association,

who will be enrolled **full-time** in a recognized post-secondary education institution for the following academic year.

Applicants must meet the admission standards of the educational institution specified, which must be a university, college or other educational institution located in Canada providing courses at a post-secondary school level.

Applicants must have actively participated in ringette as player, coach and/or mentor or on-ice official for at least five of the last seven years and a minimum one year is with Westside Ringette Association.

Successful applicants will be those who have demonstrated sustained commitment to the sport of ringette through playing, coaching, mentoring, or officiating and other volunteer activities.

Applications must be received no later than March 15.

Scholarship funds must be applied to the academic year for which the scholarship was awarded. Westside Ringette Association is unable to grant requests to defer scholarships from one academic year to the next.
